

MASTER PLAN FOR LAND USE COMMUNITY VISIONING WORKSHOP

The City of Marshall Planning Commission would like to extend an invitation to participate in the process of developing a future vision for the City of Marshall. The Planning Commission has been working on an update of the City's Master Plan for Land Use that will outline the future land use, development and redevelopment policies of the City for the next 15 - 20 years.
