

Cultural & Historic Resources

There are no known prehistoric resources within the park according to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. Historical information dates back 1837, the year Lenox Township was officially founded. By 1875, primary exports were lumber and agricultural products, with the Salt River supporting several mills and Deer Creek and tributaries providing water for agriculture, as well as other purposes (Leeson's *History of Macomb County, Michigan*, pp.877ff). Remnants of the agrarian culture are located within Wetzel SRA as evidenced by the remains of farmstead foundations at two locations (source: Michigan Department of Natural Resources).
