

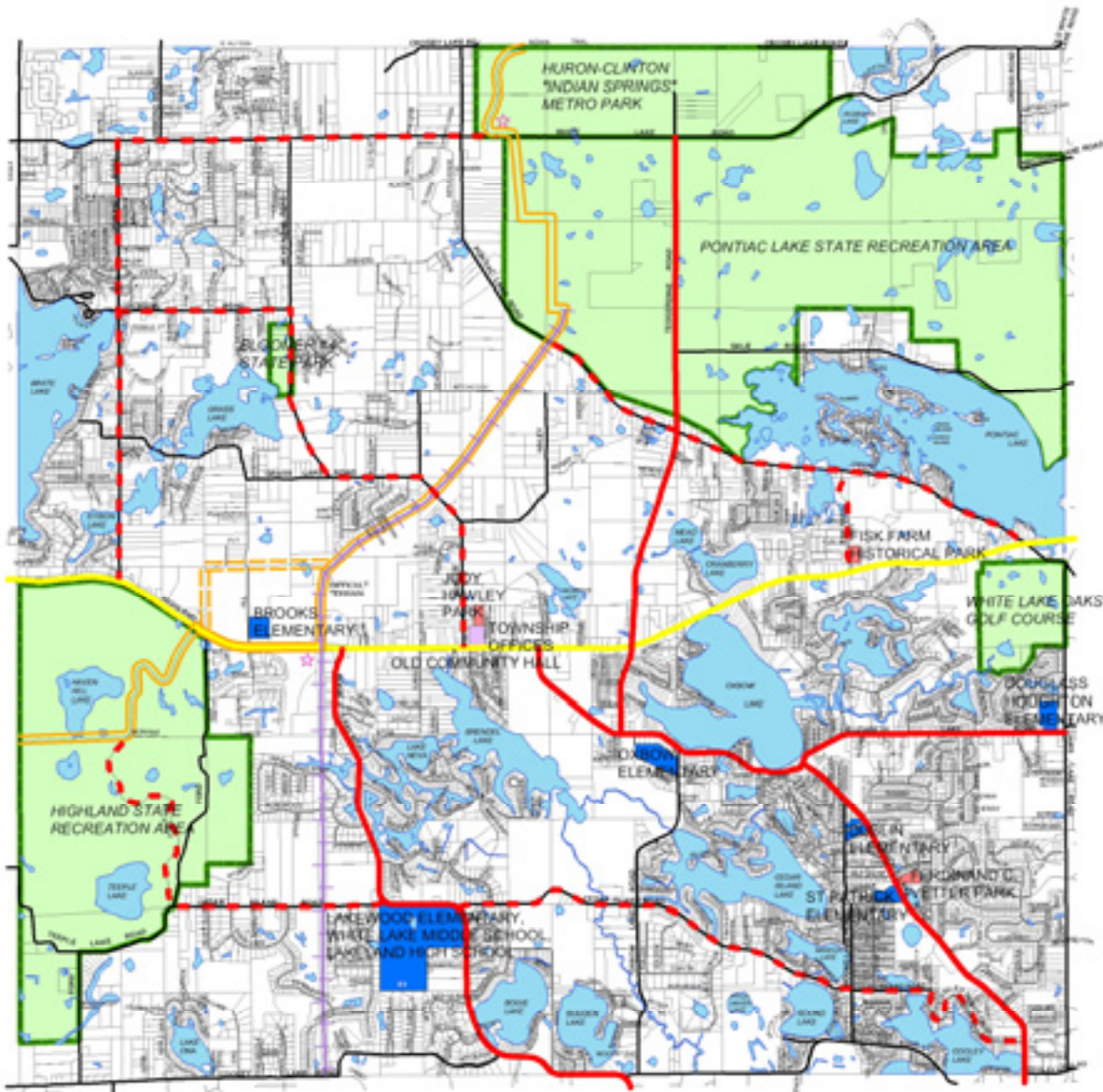


7 RECREATION PLAN

The 2005-2009 *Recreation Plan* for the Charter Township of White Lake was developed by the White Lake Township Parks and Recreation Committee, and adopted by the Township Board on March 15, 2005. The Plan covers a 5-year time frame, and includes a set of goals and objectives for White Lake to seek to accomplish during the duration of this plan and into the future. Major recreation plan goals include expanding the number and size of Township parks and establishing a multi-use pathways system. The document was developed according to the standards of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, and its approval makes White Lake Township eligible to apply for grant funding through the State of Michigan for parks and recreation purposes.

To ensure that parks and recreation issues are incorporated into discussion of land use, and to stress the importance of the continued development of the pathways system, the *2005-2009 Recreation Plan* is incorporated into this Master Plan by reference.
